Enclosed is a pamphlet containing various sections of the current restrictive covenant with the proposed changes (**bold & [brackets]**) and deletions (~~strickthroughs~~). On the right side of the pages are boxes with explanations of the changes and how the changes will benefit the Association.

If you support these changes, please sign the enclosed proxy and return it to PIHA. The proxy is simply an instruction that informs the Board of Directors that you agree with the proposed changes and that the Board can act to change the restrictive covenant. This proxy applies only to these changes in the restrictive covenants. This proxy does not affect your voting rights on other issues to be brought before the membership in the future.

The mission statement of the PIHA is “To resourcefully and responsibly manage its assets in order to promote and maintain an exceptional lifestyle that may be shared and enjoyed by all its members.” Your board of directors takes this statement very seriously.
