I would like to thank all those members who attended our April board meeting. We appreciate your input.

Hailstorm Update: A Zoom call was held today, April 26, with the insurance adjustor, our insurance agent, 2 members of the board and Jacob. It seems things are beginning to happen. Our next call is scheduled in 2 weeks. On a positive note, the board approved the craft room window to be replaced, which was completed last week.

Grand Lake Beach: Some additional changes are coming to the docks. Imagine you are standing on GLB looking out at the lake. To the right of the launching dock will be 'motorized only' area. There will be 2-3 docks available for members to pull their boats in for daily use - have a picnic, use the restrooms, let the kids play. Left of the launching dock will be designated as 'non-motorized' area for the safety of all. The swim area is already established there and we will add a kayak launch and paddleboat dock. The board approved the purchase of the kayak launch which can also be used for paddleboards. This has been ordered and hopefully will arrive soon. At our May board meeting, we will discuss the paddleboat proposals.
