Campground Rules

The Campground Manager shall have and exercise authority to stop unsafe conditions, practices or conduct.

- A. 5 MPH limit within campground or you will be asked to vacate.
- B. All pets must be under the immediate control of the owner. Pets must not be left un-attended at the campsite. Clean up after your pet. *No pets in the restrooms or campers pavilion.*
- C. No outside appliances.
- D. No surface dumping of gray or black water on site.
- E. Limit of 1 guest campsite on holiday weekends.
- F. No doubling up on campsites.
- G. One (1) tent or shade structure is allowed on a campsite along with a RV unit.
- H. Trash must be immediately placed in dumpster. Do not store trash outside your unit.
- I. Sites are to be kept neat and clean. Personal items must be kept inside or be approved by manager for storage under rear of RV only.
- J. Seasonal camping season begins 5-1 and ends 11-1 each year. All RV units and any approved structures erected must be removed at the end of the season.
- K. Sub-leasing of seasonal sites is prohibited and will result in immediate removal from campground and loss of any future seasonal camping sites for violation of this rule.
- L. No permanent individual utility hook-ups allowed, i.e., phone, water, cable tv, electric.
- M. Loose items will be removed by camp manager and disposed of after 24 hours.
- N. All motorized vehicles may ride only to their site or to enter or exit the campground.
- O. 2 motorized vehicles (other than camping unit) allowed per site. Storage of additional boats, snowmobiles (when not in use), and all other vehicles or miscellaneous equipment is not allowed on the campsite. All boats and other vehicles must be stored in the designated storage area.
- P. Overflow parking is available only at pavilion or storage area.
- Q. All owners are responsible for their guest's actions.
- R. Bicycles are not allowed on paths.
- S. Check out time 1 P.M.
- T. Quiet time is 10 P.M. to 8 A.M.
- U. No Fireworks of any kind.
- V. Vandalism will not be tolerated and will be cause for immediate eviction.
- W. Parents are responsible for their child's behavior and safety.
- X. Failure to follow established rules will result in eviction from campground.
- Y. Campfires are permitted in the campsite fire pit only.
- Z. No Structures of any kind including storage sheds, stairs, or porches not a part of the original equipment on a recreational vehicle may not be erected without prior permission from the Executive Director or his designee. At any time in the future if the structure is deemed not to fulfill the aesthetic or structural standards of the campground by the Executive Director, it must be removed at the Campers Expense within thirty days. Transient Campers will not be allowed to erect any structures on the site.

The Executive Director should examine and revise if necessary, all the rules of the campground, and when complete have them posted on the outside bulletin board outside the office. They should be passed out to each camper when they check in each year.
